For your assistance, following is a checklist of major items that should be considered in order to build a successful Society/Organization:

Formal Name of Society or Organization (be sure to check for duplication) Bylaws/Standing Rules/ **Procedures Creation Qualifications for Joining** Board/Council Construction (to ensure good working size) Tax ID Number ("EIN") Banking (we recommend minimum of two signers on all accounts [checking/ savings/CDs/&c.]) Society Emblem **Application and Instructions** Membership Certificate Development of Society Insignia/ Regalia/Banner/Flag
